- 3. Assist in setting up rooms and supplies
- 4. Welcome and engage kids as they enter our space
- 5. Communicate with parents and make them feel excited about dropping of their kids and leaving them in our care
- 6. Assist in checking in and out of kids
- 7. Assist in cleaning up the space
- 8. To give some thought to how you might improve for the next day
- 9. Work in alignment to the philosophy of Kids Ministry and clearly integrate the wider church values of hospitality, transformation, and mission

- Must be 16+years old to fulfill ratio requirements
